what's happening ?

In June 2025, a proposal was submitted to **transfer pernambuco from CITES Appendix II to Appendix I**.

If this proposal is approved in November 2025, it will **prohibit all international trade of this unique wood** - essential for crafting professional-quality bows for string instruments.

consequences:

- **impoverished musical performances**
- a requirement for **CITES certificates each time a musician travels** and an obligation to get these certificates **stamped at every border crossing**
- a requirement for **CITES certificates to buy, sell or repair a bow**
- a *de facto* prohibition on the use of timber from plantations, resulting in a **risk to current conservation efforts** of the pernambuco tree
- the **end to the bowmaking craft** that has been passed down since the 18th century

what can you do?

- Raise awareness of this issue
- be prepared to contact the relevant authorities if this transferal is proposed
- consider joining, or donating to, the IPCI to support our efforts for musicians and the conservation of pernambuco
