The Hirer shall ensure a safe supply of electricity and the security of the musicians and their property at the venue. 	 The Hirer shall not make or permit the making of any audio and/or visual recording or transmission of the musicians' performance without the prior written consent of the musicians. This Agreement may not be modified or cancelled except by mutual consent, in writing signed by both parties. Any rider attached hereto and signed by both parties shall be deemed incorporated into this Agreement.
